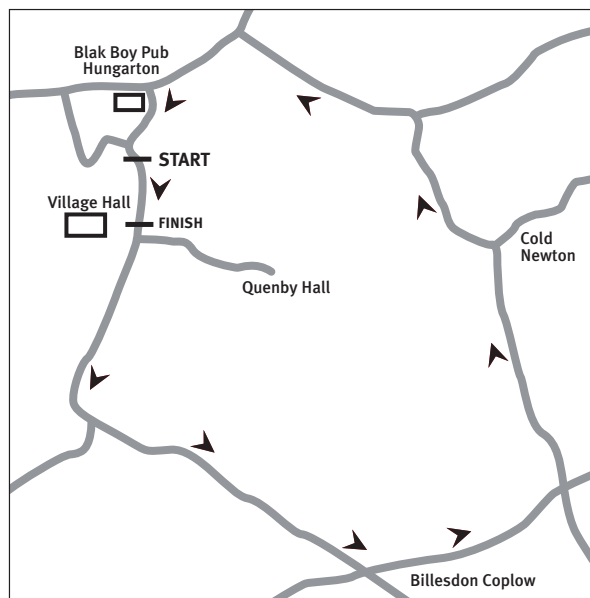

As last year, the race will revert back to the 'original' course. Leaving Hungarton, heading towards Keyham and Billesdon Coplow and taking in the lovely downhill of Sludge Hill. The race will still of course have mile markers, drinks stations and a fast efficient results service.

The race remains at the fore-front of the Leicestershire Road Running League and is widely regarded as Leicestershires toughest Road Race.

It has, since its inception, been a member of the Leicestershire Road Running League which has over 1000 registered members. This ensures that the race always has good support and maintains a good quality profile in running circles.
